## Solution Assessment Framework

This framework was used to guide the process of selecting solutions to profile on Parachute's Horizon. Each item has criteria 1 OR 2, and both 3 and 4.

### 1. Research

The solution or information has been found to be effective through, or presented in, one or more of the following:

- a meta-analysis
- a systematic review
- a rigorous evaluation

OR

### 2. Expert Opinion

The solution or information does not have the specified level of evidence because the nature of the topic prohibits a rigorous evaluation design, but existing research and expert opinion supports the practice and there is a clear link between the strategy and reduced risk (link between the strategy and reduced injuries may be less clear).

AND

### 3. No unsupportive findings

If applicable, there is no evidence suggesting that the solution may cause harm if implemented outside of the context of the evaluation(s).

AND

### 4. Implementation

If applicable, the solution has been implemented in a real world setting so that the practicality of the intervention has also been examined.
